The 2025 scholarship is made possible through the generosity of Queens Chapel residents and community partners who believe in the importance of helping fund the scholarship to benefit the academic aspirations of a Queens Chapel student.

The Award

A \$1,000.00 scholarship each for up to two graduating high school seniors (12th grade) in June 2025.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a current resident of the Queens Chapel Community. (See QCCA website for neighborhood boundaries)
- The applicant's household must be a paid member of the Queens Chapel Civic Association for at least two of the last two civic years 2023 and 2024. (September through June)
- The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited high school and expect to graduate in June 2025.
- The applicant must have a 2.5 or higher GPA.

The following documents must be included in your application:

1. A 500 word essay entitled, "My Academic and Career Goals".
2. Proof of involvement in extra-curricular activities and/or community service.
3. Two letters of recommendation from a class teacher, school counselor, school administrator or community representative.
4. An acceptance letter from a postsecondary institution or career/technical school.
5. An official transcript submitted by the applicant's school by mail or email.
